The Association of Pediatric Program Directors (APPD) is pleased to announce that it has received the <u>2023</u> ACGME Barbara Ross-Lee, DO Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Award.

The Barbara Ross-Lee, DO Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Award honors ACGME-accredited Sponsoring Institutions and programs, as well as specialty organizations working to diversify the underrepresented physician workforce and create inclusive workplaces that foster humane, civil, and equitable environments.

Over the past decade, APPD has developed several initiatives and programs that foster DEI and anti-racism. Those efforts include:

- Creation of the APPD LGBTQA+ Learning Community.
- Creation of the APPD Underrepresented in Medicine in Pediatric Graduate Medical Education Learning Community.
- Development of four novel mentoring programs to support UIM APPD members:
 - Advancing Inclusiveness in Medical Education Scholars (AIMS), for UIM pediatric residents interested in medical education;
 - 2. UIM Chief Residents Mentoring Program;
 - Fostering Underrepresented in Medicine Educational Leaders (FUEL), for UIM junior faculty;
 - 4. UIM Coordinators Mentorship Program.

 - 1. Creation of the APPD Anti-Racism Action Team.
 - Increasing the diversity of our workforce through the APPD Confronting Racism Action Team, Pediatrics 2025: AMSPDC Workforce Initiative, and ACGME Equity Matters.
 - 3. Collaboration with the Council on Medical Student Education in Pediatrics (COMSEP, our UME counterpart) by partnering with 30 organizations and over 150 individuals to build stronger pathways into medicine, from early childhood through faculty.
